Instructions:

1. Simple web page with JDeveloper.

2. Personal homepage

Create a homepage for yourself and practice the use of HTML. You need to use .jsp files instead of .htm files. Your homepage needs to have the following elements:

- Content: site title, main menu, your name, education, work, family, hobby, favorite sites ... (you can use one page or several pages)
- HTML elements: webpage title, heading (<h1> and other levels), image (), links (<a>), list (or), table (<table>), paragraph with alignment (<p>)

Run the web page with the built-in server in JDeveloper.

Submission

- A screenshot of the JDeveloper environment (with the page in design view);
- Complete source code, printed out separately (pasted in Word).

Note: screenshots need to be complete and original, no graphic editing. Clearly name and label all screenshots and source code.
